

DALLAS LOVE FIELD COMPLETES AND OPENS MORE THAN 1100 NEW PARKING SPACES

(DALLAS, TX) – On June 29, 2002, Dallas Love Field will open more than 1,100 new covered parking spaces for public use as a part of its 18-month parking garage construction project. “The new spaces are covered, they’re close, and they’re convenient,” said Kenneth Gwyn, Director of Aviation, Dallas Love Field. Upon completion of the entire project scheduled to open February 2003, the new four-level garage will provide more than 4,000 additional parking spaces, increasing parking garage capacity to more than 7,000 vehicles.

“With the availability of these 1,100-plus additional parking spaces, the City of Dallas is meeting its goal to improve service to customers at Dallas Love Field,” said Gwyn.

“The new garage will offer a tremendous upgrade in service and convenience to Love Field travelers, and ultimately it will include a climate-controlled pedestrian concourse complete with a moving walkway and a public art exhibit. We’re on budget and on schedule for the new garage to open as planned.”

The East Parking Lot will remain open with shuttle service to the terminal throughout construction. Love Field travelers can hear current parking and traffic information 24 hours a day by tuning to 1580 AM radio within three miles of the airport or by calling 214 670-PARK.
