


DEPARTURES PER RUNWAY




Total Operations April








DEPARTURES PER RUNWAY







RUNWAY UTILIZATION BY AIRLINE DURING PREFERENTIAL HOURS (RAW DATA)



Percentage Airline utilized preferential runway (Raw Data)



CASPER UPDATES

- Casper is obtaining a new subcontractor to build the 4th noise monitor
 - Expect construction to begin late Summer
- Air Traffic Control Receiver
 - Will attempt to construct at same time as noise monitor
