Construction Updates

Runway Closures

Important Notice UPDATE

* August 3rd – 7th, there will be a closure of Taxiway B for a week inhibiting some aircraft operations to use the preferential runway during nighttime hours. You may encounter a higher than normal noise impact during this time.*

Scheduled Runway and Taxiway Closures

All closures will be coordinated through Airport Operations and will be permitted based on weather and operational impact.

- ❖ Fri/July 31st 0700 – 1700: Taxiway B will be closed between Taxiway B5 and Taxilane Q for MCM saw cutting pavement.
- ❖ Sat /Aug 1st 0700 – 1700: Taxiway B will be closed between Taxiway B5 and Taxilane Q for MCM saw cutting pavement.
- ❖ Sun/Aug 2nd at 2330 – Mon/Aug 3rd at 0500: Runway 13R/31L closed for Airfield Maintenance painting markings and mowing.
- ❖ Mon/Aug 3rd at 0700 – Fri/Aug 7th at 1700: Taxiway B closed between Taxiway B5 and Taxilane Q for MCM.
- ❖ Mon/Aug 3rd at 2330 – Tue/Aug 4th at 0500: Taxiway B closed between Reeves Ramp and the approach end of Runway 13L for Airfield maintenance painting markings.
- ❖ Tue/Aug 4th at 2330 – Wed/ Aug 5th at 0500: Taxiway B and Runway 18/36 intersection for Airfield Maintenance painting taxiway markings.
- ❖ Wed/Aug 5th at 2330 – Thur/ Aug 6th at 0500: Runway 13L/31R closed for Airfield Maintenance painting markings and mowing.

Ongoing Airfield Closures

The following taxiways will remain closed until further notice:

- ❖ Taxiway D closed between Taxiway C and D1.
- ❖ Taxiway D1, ongoing daily closures, weather permitting, from 0700-1700 as required for work on the shoulder. Taxiway D will be available at Taxiway D1 intersection.
- ❖ Taxiway B closed between Taxiway B1 and Taxiway S for MCM pavement work.
- ❖ Taxilane P closed for RON C/Taxilane P realignment

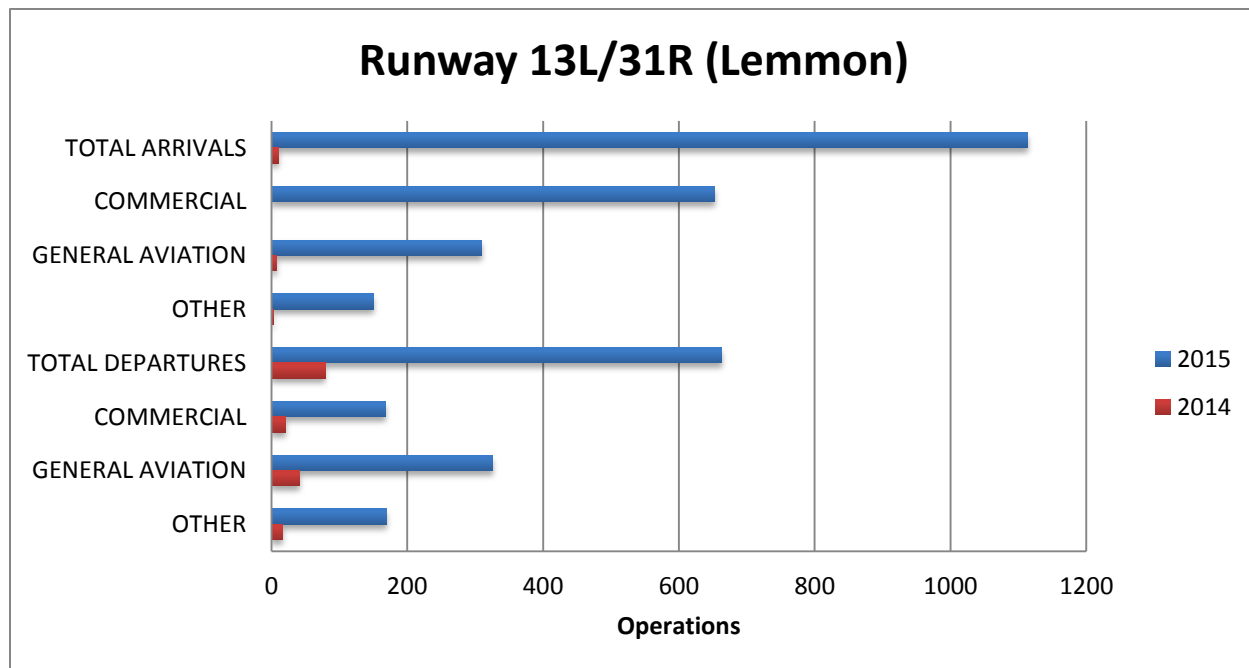

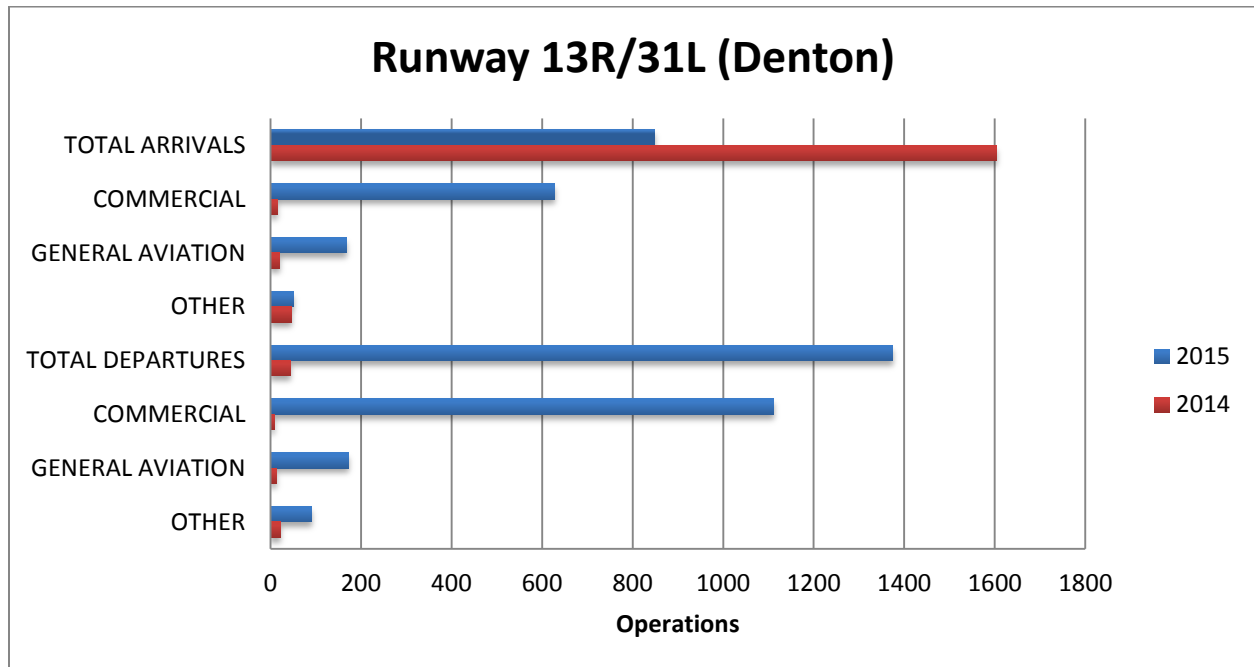
