NOVEMBER 22, 1963

- 11:35am Vice President Lyndon B. Johnson's jet, Air Force Two, lands on runway 31[R] and taxis to gate 28A. As a matter of protocol, the Vice President of the United States always lands first to welcome the President of the United States.
- 11:39am President John F. Kennedy's jet, Air Force One, lands on runway 31[R] and taxis to gate 28A. Over 2,000 people gather to welcome the Presidential party. President Kennedy stops and shakes hands with those who came to greet him.
- 11:55am Presidential party departs gate 28A for a motorcade through downtown Dallas and on to the Trade Mart.
- 12:30pm President Kennedy is assassinated in Dealey Plaza in downtown Dallas. Texas Governor John B. Connally, also riding in the President's vehicle is seriously wounded. President Kennedy & Governor Connally are rushed to Parkland Hospital.
- 1:00pm President Kennedy is pronounced dead.
- 1:26pm As a matter of security, US Secret Service orders Vice President Johnson to depart Parkland Hospital en route to Air Force One, before it is publicly announced President Kennedy had died.
- 1:33pm President Kennedy's death announced from Parkland Hospital.
- 1:39pm Vice President & Mrs. Johnson arrive Dallas Love Field and board Air Force One. The Vice President & Mrs. Johnson wait for Mrs. Kennedy and President Kennedy's body to arrive.
- 2:15pm President Kennedy's body and Presidential entourage arrive at Love Field and his body is carried onto Air Force One.
- 2:38pm U.S. Federal Judge Sarah T. Hughes administers the Presidential Oath of Office to Vice President Johnson in the stateroom aboard Air Force One. The swearing in ceremony lasts 28 seconds.
- 2:47pm Air Force One departs Dallas Love Field Airport en route to Andrews Air Force Base near Washington, D.C.

On the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, and the first inauguration of President Lyndon B. Johnson, this historical marker is dedicated at the exact site where Air Force One was parked on November 22, 1963.

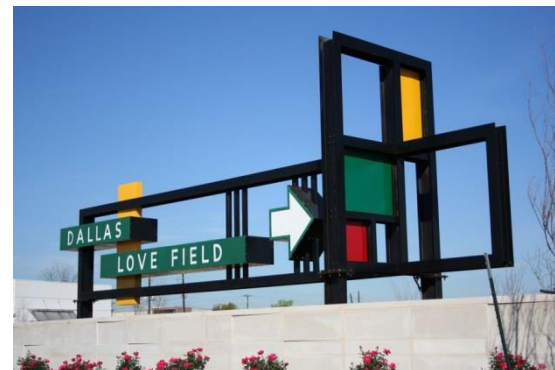

Construction Updates

Runway Closures

Scheduled Runway and Taxiway Closures

All closures will be coordinated through Airport Operations and will be permitted based on weather and operational impact.

- Tue/Sept 8th at 1800 – Wed/Sept 9th at 0500: Taxiway B between Taxiway B5 and Taxilane Q will be closed for MCM (concrete contractor) /EAS (electrical contractor).
- Tue/Sept 8th at 2330 – Wed/ Sept 9th at 0500: Taxiways B5 and B6 will be between Runway 13L/31R and Taxiway B for Airfield Maintenance painting centerline, enhanced centerline and edge lines.
- Wed/Sept 9th at 2330 – Thur/ Sept 10th at 0500: Runway 13L/31R closed for Airfield Maintenance conducting rubber removal and painting runway hold position markings at Taxiways B3, B4 and B at the departure end of Runway 13L.
- Thur/Sept 10th at 2330 – Fri/Sept 11th at 0500: Taxiway C at Taxiway C4 closed for Airfield Maintenance painting centerline and edge markings.

Ongoing Airfield Closures

The following taxiways will remain closed until further notice:

- Taxiway D closed between Taxiway C and D1.
- Taxiway D1, closed as needed from 0700-1700 for work on the shoulder. Taxiway D will be available at Taxiway D1 intersection.
- Taxiway B closed between Taxiway B1 and Taxiway S for MCM pavement work.
- Taxilane P closed for RON C/Taxilane P realignment. RON (Remain Over Night) A realigned to that location and Taxilane P relocated and redesignated Taxiway P
- Taxiway D between Taxiway B & Taxilane Q, Taxiway B5 between Taxiways B & D and Taxiways D2 & D3 (Taxiway P renamed Taxiway D2) will be closed for 17 days for MCM installing taxiway lighting and other work associated with the relocation of Taxiway P, reopens Fri/Sept 4th at 1800.

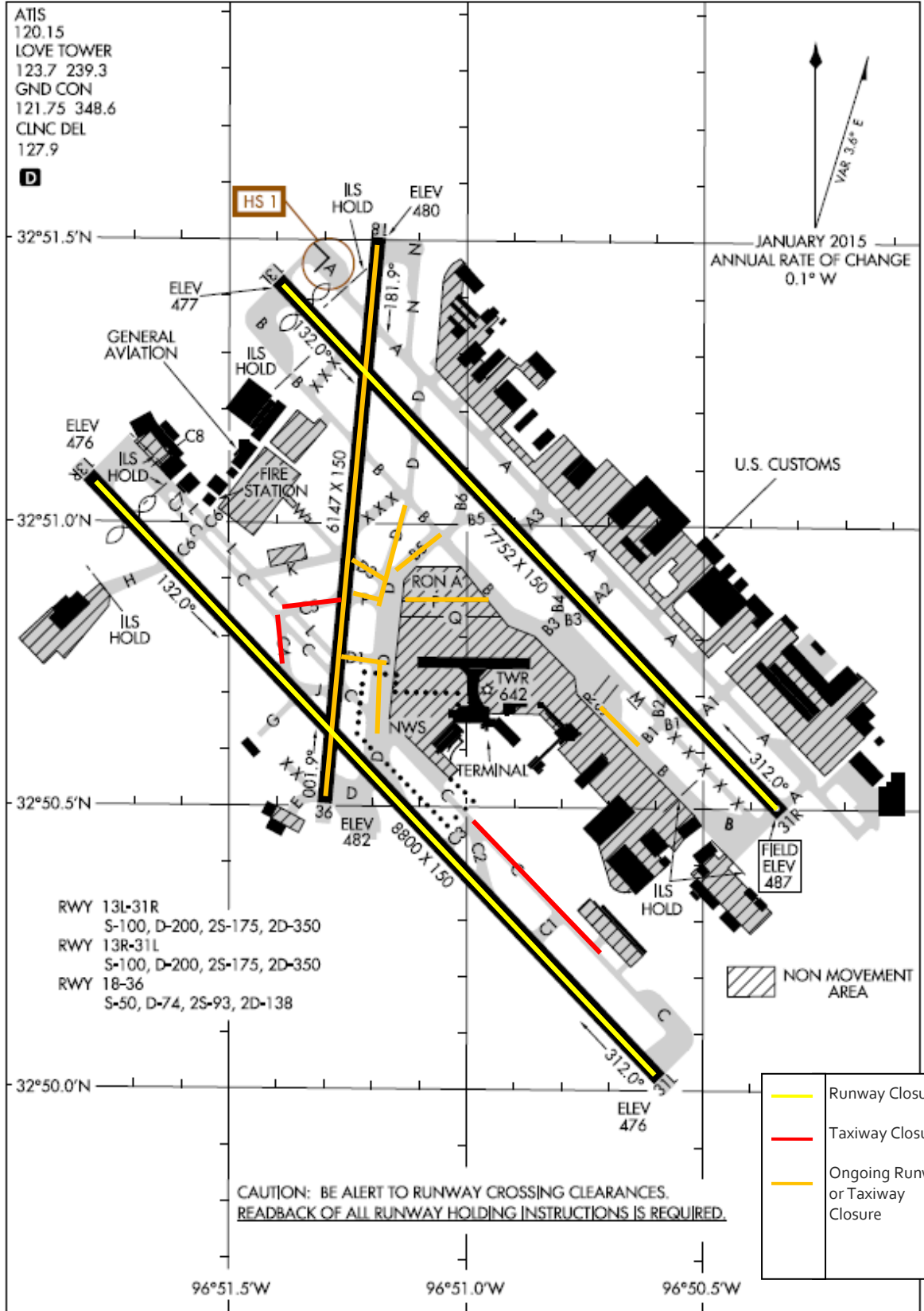

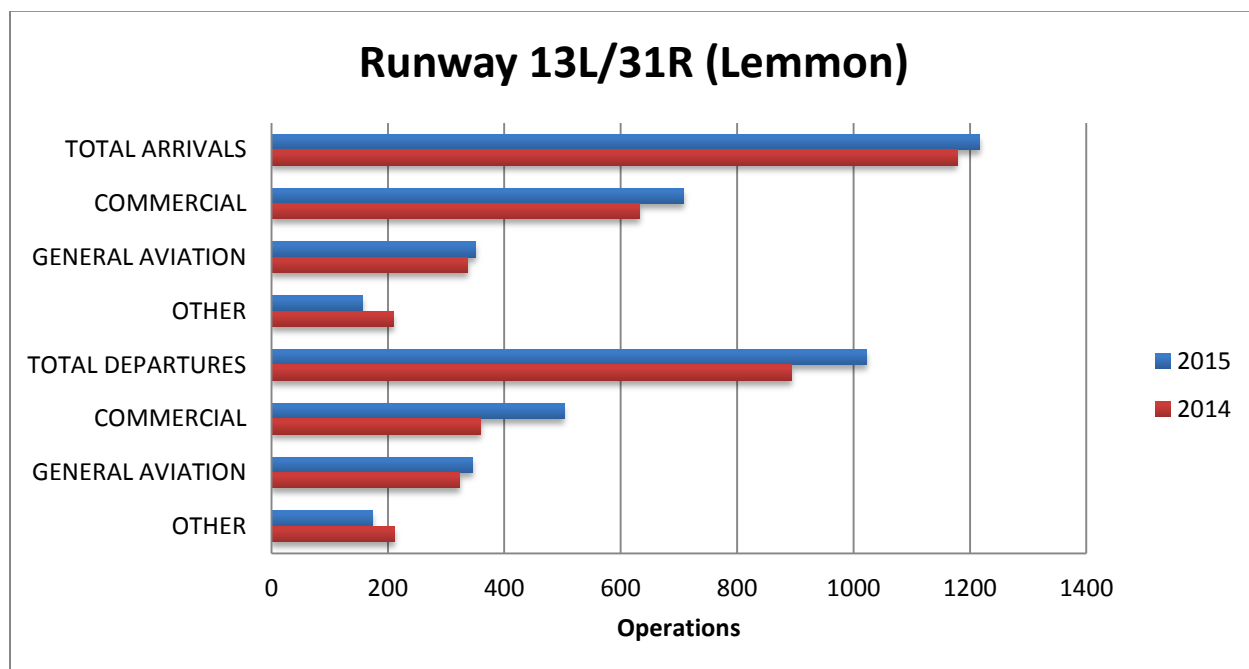

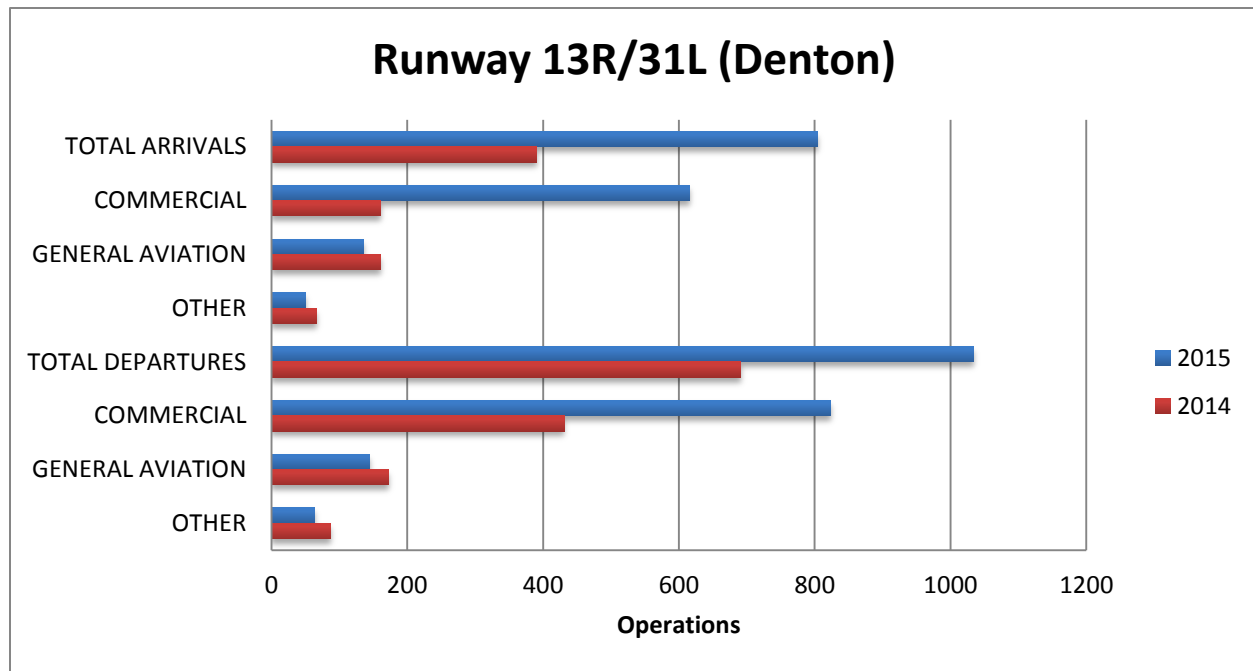
